Chairman Lanni called the meeting to order in Open Session at 9:10 a.m.

All Board Members present reviewed the Open Minutes of the August 19, 2010 Board Meeting. A Motion was made by Frank Montanaro and seconded by Gerald Goldstein to accept the Open Minutes as written, and it was unanimously

The meeting continued in open session:

CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVES:

1. Case No. EE-3448 (Now known as EE-3448A)
Coventry Fire District & International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF)

As a result of a merger of two (2) Locals within the Coventry Fire District / Anthony Fire Department, the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) petitioned this Board for an amendment of the Certification of Representatives; thus, reflecting a name change of Coventry Fire District / Anthony Fire Department and Central Coventry Fire Fighters, Local 3372, International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF). Additionally, the parties submitted an additional amendment of the Certification of Representatives to exclude three (3) positions, Chief of the Department, Secretary to the Chief, and Tax Collector.

Upon review of all documentation submitted by the parties, a Motion was made by Frank Montanaro and seconded by Gerald Goldstein to acknowledge and approve the amended Certification of Representatives reflecting a name change to Coventry Fire District / Anthony Fire Department and Central Coventry Fire Fighters, Local 3372, International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF). After discussion, all Board Members voted in favor of the Motion. Motion passed.

A second Motion was then made by Frank Montanaro and seconded by Gerald Goldstein to acknowledge and approve the amendment to the Certification of Representatives, reflecting that the position(s) of **Chief of the Department, Secretary to the Chief, and Tax Collector**, be **excluded** from the bargaining unit now known as and defined by Certification No. EE-3448A. After discussion, all Board Members voted in favor of the Motion. Motion passed.

2. Case No. ULP- 5928
City of Providence & International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF), Local 799
