Case No. EE-3744
 Town of Westerly & International Brotherhood of Police Officers (IBPO)
 (Review of Matter)

After review and discussion of the aforementioned matter with the Attorney of the Board, a Motion was made by Aronda R. Kirby and seconded by Kenneth B. Chiavarini to reconsider the previously determined Motion, made on October 3, 2017, to wit: to proceed with a Formal Hearing. After discussion, Aronda R. Kirby, Alberto Aponte Cardona, and Kenneth B. Chiavarini voted in favor of reversing the previous Motion. Walter J. Lanni, Marcia B. Reback, and Scott G. Duhamel opposed the Motion. Motion failed based on procedural grounds 3-3. This case was heard formally by Walter Lanni, Frank Montanaro, Marcia B. Reback, Aronda R. Kirby, and Scott G. Duhamel. All participating Board Members reviewed the transcript(s) and briefs, as well as the evidence submitted therein.

After review of the drafted Decision and Order, a Motion was made by Marcia B. Reback and seconded by Aronda R. Kirby to sign the Decision and Order, as written, and to refer the case back to the Administrator of the Board for final proofing; with the direction to issue the same as soon as possible. After discussion, all participating Board Members voted in favor of the Motion and did sign the signature page of the Decision and Order, as written. Motion passed.



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ORDER: 1) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from retaliating against Petitioner for exercising her right to file grievances and/or pursue arbitrations. 2) The Employer is hereby ordered to expunge from Petitioner's personnel file any reference that Ms. lafrate allegedly called Ms. Reynolds a deadbeat or that she said, "we don't make mistakes" or "people have to pay their bills" and the January 12, 2017 suspension received in connection with same. 3) The Employer is hereby ordered to rescind the five (5) day suspension without pay and reinstate Ms. lafrate's wages for the days of her suspension.

A Motion was then made by Aronda R. Kirby for the Board to go into Closed Session for the purpose of reviewing the Closed Minutes and Unfair Labor Practice Charges, pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §42-46-5(a) (2) (4) of the Open Meetings Law. Scott G. Duhamel seconded the Motion and it was unanimously
