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ORDER: 1) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from retaliating against Elizabeth lafrate for exercising her right to file grievances and/or pursue arbitrations and/or file unfair labor practice charges with this Board. 2) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from discriminating against Elizabeth lafrate for exercising her right to file grievances and/or pursue arbitrations. 3) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from undermining or disparaging the Union in any communications the Town has with members of the bargaining unit. 4) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from refusing to engage in either mediation or good faith bargaining with the Union in accordance with R.I.G.L. 28-7-12. 5) The Employer is hereby ordered to post a copy of this Decision and Order for a period of not less than sixty (60) days in each building where bargaining unit personnel work, said posting to be in a location where other materials designed to be seen, read and reviewed by bargaining unit personnel are posted.
