Case No. EE-3575

1 Case No. ULP- 6286 Community College of Rhode Island – Rhode Island Council on Post Secondary Education & Community College of Rhode Island Professional Staff Association/NEARI

After review of the above-entitled matter, a Motion was made by Derek M. Silva and seconded by Scott G. Duhamel to uphold the agreed upon violation as stated in the Complaint of the matter; and that this matter be referred to the Board's Legal Counsel for drafting of such Decision and Order to that effect. After discussion, Scott G. Duhamel, Derek M. Silva, and Stan Israel voted in favor of the Motion. Walter J. Lanni, Aronda R. Kirby, Kenneth B. Chiavarini, and Harry F. Winthrop opposed the Motion. Motion failed.

Subsequently, a Motion was made by Kenneth B. Chiavarini and seconded by Aronda R. Kirby to dismiss the violations as stated in the Complaint of the matter; and that this matter be referred to the Board's Legal Counsel for drafting of such Decision and Order to that effect. After discussion, Walter J. Lanni, Aronda R. Kirby, Kenneth B. Chiavarini, and Harry F. Winthrop voted in favor of the Motion. Scott G. Duhamel, Derek M. Silva, and Stan Israel opposed the Motion. Motion passed.

DECISION & ORDER: (Review and Determination)

 Case No. ULP- 6276
 State of Rhode Island – Department of Health & RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 2870

This case was heard formally by Walter J. Lanni, Scott G. Duhamel, Aronda R. Kirby, Derek M. Silva, Harry F. Winthrop, and Stan Israel. Kenneth B. Chiavarini, as well as the aforementioned Board Members reviewed the transcript(s) and briefs, as well as the evidence submitted therein.

After review of the drafted Decision and Order, a Motion was made by Derek M. Silva and seconded by Stan Israel to sign the Decision and Order, as written, and to refer the case back to the Administrator of the Board for final proofing; with the direction to issue the same as soon as possible. After discussion, all Board Members voted and did sign the Decision & Order, as written. Aronda R. Kirby, Kenneth B. Chiavarini and Harry F. Winthrop signed as dissent. Motion passed.

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ORDER: 1) The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from making unilateral changes to working terms and conditions of employment, as it did when it reassigned Ramona Santos to the COVID letters team, without first notifying the Union and giving it the opportunity to bargain over any proposed changes. 2) The Employer is hereby ordered to post a copy of this Decision and Order for a period of not less than sixty (60) days in each building where bargaining unit personnel work, said posting to be in a location where other materials designed to be seen, read and reviewed by bargaining unit personnel are posted.
