Mr. Silva expressed his pleasure in serving on the Board, and all Board Members agreed that Mr. Silva was an exemplary Board Member who represented labor fairly and effectively and will be missed.

All Board Members present reviewed the Open Minutes of the January 19, 2023 Board Meeting. A Motion was made by Stan Israel and seconded by Kenneth B. Chiavarini to accept the Open Minutes as written, and it was

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### **CONSENT AGREEMENT & AFFIDAVIT MATTERS:**

1 Case No. EE- 3646 Town of Johnston & Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local 808 (Accretion of Director of Buildings and Grounds)



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After review of the Consent Agreement and Affidavit executed and presented by the parties, a Motion was made by Aronda R. Kirby and seconded by Stan Israel, to acknowledge and accept the parties' signed Consent Agreement and Affidavit. Accordingly, the position(s) of: Director of Buildings and Grounds shall be accreted into the bargaining unit as defined in Certification of Representatives – Case No. EE-3646. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in favor of the Motion. Motion passed.

2 Case No. EE- 3646 Town of Johnston & Rhode Island Laborers' District Council on behalf of Local 808 (Exclusion of Director of Recreational and Community Services)

After review of the Consent Agreement and Affidavit executed and presented by the parties, a Motion was made by Stan Israel and seconded by Aronda R. Kirby, to acknowledge and accept the parties' signed Consent Agreement and Affidavit. Accordingly, the position(s) of: Director of Recreational and Community Services shall be excluded from the bargaining unit as defined in Certification of Representatives — Case No. EE-3646. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in favor of the Motion. Motion passed.

### **CONCLUDED CASES: (Review and Determination):**

1 ULP- 6327 State of Rhode Island - Department of Public Safety – Division of Sheriffs & RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 2409

After review of the above-entitled matter, a Motion was made by Stan Israel and seconded by Scott G. Duhamel to uphold the unfair labor practice in this matter; and that this matter be referred to the Board's Legal Counsel for drafting of such Decision and Order to that effect. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in opposition to the Motion. Motion failed.

A Motion was then made by Kenneth B. Chiavarini and seconded by Aronda R. Kirby to deny and dismiss the unfair labor practice Charge in this matter; and that this matter be referred to the Board's Legal Counsel for drafting of such Decision and Order of Dismissal to that effect. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in favor of the Motion. Motion passed.



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### **DECISION & ORDER MATTERS: (Review and Determination/Signing):**

 Case No. ULP- 6328 West Warwick Housing Authority & RI Council 94, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 2045-1

This case was heard formally by Walter J. Lanni, Aronda R. Kirby, Harry F. Winthrop and Stan Israel, as well as all Board Members present reviewed the transcript(s) and briefs, as well as the evidence submitted herein.

After review of the Drafted Decision and Order of Dismissal, a Motion was made by Aronda R. Kirby and seconded by Kenneth B. Chiavarini to sign the Decision and Order of Dismissal, as written, and to refer the case back to the Programming Services Officer of the Board for final proofing; with the direction to issue the same as soon as possible. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in favor of the Motion and signed the Decision & Order of Dismissal, as written. Motion passed.

ORDER: This case is hereby dismissed with no finding of any violation of the Act.

2. Case No. ULP- 6330 State of Rhode Island – Department for Children, Youth and Families & Rhode Island Alliance of Social Service Employees, Local 580, SEIU

This case was decided, at the request of the parties, by Consent Order, Stipulated Facts and Briefs. All Board Members present reviewed the Consent Order, Stipulated Facts and Briefs submitted herein.

After review of the Drafted Decision and Order, a Motion was made by Scott G. Duhamel and seconded by Stan Israel to sign the Decision and Order, as written, and to refer the case back to the Programming Services Officer of the Board for final proofing; with the direction to issue the same as soon as possible. After discussion, all Board Members present voted in favor of the Motion and signed the Decision & Order, as written. Motion passed.

ORDER: 1. The Employer is hereby ordered to cease and desist from refusing to provide relevant documents and information to the Union which the Union claims are relevant to its administration of disciplinary matters involving bargaining unit members. 2. The Employer is hereby ordered to post a copy of this Decision and Order for a period of not less than sixty (60) days in each building where bargaining unit personnel work, said posting to be in a location where other materials designed to be seen, read and reviewed by bargaining unit personnel are posted.
